MANCHESTER ART GALLERY AND PRIDE IN AGEING AT LGBT FOUNDATION HAVE BEEN WORKING IN PARTNERSHIP TO CREATE A DEREK JARMAN POCKET PARK AT THE MOSLEY STREET ENTRANCE OF MANCHESTER ART GALLERY. This NEW COMMUNITY GARDEN SPACE HAS BEEN DESIGNED AND PLANTED BY A VOLUNTEER GROUP OF GREEN-FINGERED LGBTA+ OVER 50S FROM GREATER MANCHESTER, WITH SUPPORT FROM ARTIST JULIET DAVIS-DUFAYARD. FUNDING WAS PROVIDED BY THE MINISTRY OF HOUSING, COMMUNITIES AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT POCKET PARKS, POSTCODE LOTTERY TRUST AND THE MANCHESTER WELLBEING FUND. AS WELL AS PROVIDING A FUNCTIONAL SPACE FOR MANCHESTER ART GALLERY'S CLIMATE AND WELLBEING WORK THE GARDEN IS A PLACE FOR THE PEOPLE OF MANCHESTER AND THE WIDER WORLD TO COME TOGETHER, RELAX, SHARE IDEAS AND ENJOY A TASTE OF "IMMERSIVE NATURE" IN THE CENTRE OF THE CITY. GARDEN DESIGN SUPPORT HAS BEEN KINDLY PROVIDED BY EXTERIOR BRCHITECTURE, ROYAL HORTICULTURAL SOCIETY AND UNITED UTILITIES (AS PARTNERS IN THE IGNITION PROJECT), AND THE GARDEN CONTAINS A NUMBER OF INNOVATIVE URBAN SOLUTIONS TO COMBAT THE EFFECTS OF CLIMATE CHANGE.

THE DEREK JARMAN POCKET PARK IS INSPIRED BY FILMMAKER, GAY RIGHTS ACTIVIST AND GARDENER DEREK JARMAN'S CELEBRATED GARDEN IN DUNGENESS AS WELL AS THE LIFE EXPERIENCES OF OUR LGBTQ+ VOLUNTEER GROUP, WHO ARE OF THE SAME OR SIMILAR GENERATIONS TO JARMAN. 

MANCHESTER ART GALLERY, EXTERIOR ARCHITECTURE, RHS IGNITION PROJECT AND ARTIST JULIET DAVIS-DRUFAYARD TO PLAN AND CREATE A JARMAN-INSPIRED GARDEN IN THIS SPACE, WHICH EVERYONE WILL BE WELCOME TO USE.





THE SETTING

Some of you may recognise this strip of land in Manchester city centre – the stone flags, Victorian iron fencing, a background of office blocks and a glimpse to the right of a Grade I listed building. It's a small part of the land surrounding Manchester firt Gallery. Most of us have probably given it little thought as we walk down Mosley Street, but for a small group of us, it was the subject of many Zoom meetings during 2021.

DEREK JARMAN PROTEST! (DEC 2021 - RPRIL 2022), FOCUSED ON THE DIVERSE STRANDS OF JARMAN'S PRACTICE AS A PAINTER, FILM-MAKER, SET-DESIGNER, POLITICAL ACTIVIST AND...GARDENER.

IMAGINE A WILD AND WINDSWEPT CORNER OF THE BRITISH COASTLINE, A HEADLAND OF PEBBLES AND SHINGLE, BLASTED BY THE SUN IN SUMMER AND BATTERED BY WINTER STORMS AND SALT SPRAY, AND ALL WITHIN THE SHADOW OF A NUCLEAR POWER STATION.

NOT EXACTLY A PLACE THAT CONJURES UP THE BEAUTY OF NATURE, AND YET FOR ARTIST, FILM MAKER AND GAY ACTIVIST DEREK JARMAN, THE GARDEN HE CREATED AT PROSPECT COTTAGE IN DUNGENESS, KENT, WAS BOTH A 'THERAPY AND A PHARMACOPOEIA'.

PLMOST 30 YEARS ON FROM JARMAN'S
LANDMARK EXHIBITION 'QUEER' AT
MANCHESTER PRT GALLERY, THE GROUP
OF VOLUNTEER GARDENERS, MANY OF
WHOM ALSO CAMPAIGNED FOR GAY RIGHTS
AND AGAINST HOMOPHOBIC POLICIES AND
ATTITUDES, CONTINUE TO BE INSPIRED

KEY PRINCIPLES FOR DEREK JARMAN POCKET PARK AT MANCHESTER ART GALLERY -BY THE COLLECTIVE

I. RADICAL AND STRIKING SPACE, WHICH STIMULATES ALL LIFE FORMS THROUGHOUT THE YEAR.

IN PRACTICE: YEAR ROUND PLANTING FOR INTEREST/ROTATING PLANTS; STRUCTURAL PLANTS OF DIFFERENT HEIGHTS, SO YOU CAN SEE THEM THROUGH RAILINGS AND DIFFERENT VIEWS.

2. CELEBRATES DIFFERENCES AND
RESILIENCE, LIFE STORIES OF JARMAN, HIS
PEERS, AND ALSO LOCAL STORIES. OFFERS
A WINDOW INTO DIFFERENT LGBT LIFE
EXPERIENCES. INSPIRES PEOPLE.

IN PRACTICE: STORIES AND ENGAGEMENT WITH DIFFERENT GENERATIONS. PARALLEL DRAWN BETWEEN HIV/RIDS HISTORICALLY AND AREA TO COMMEMORATE THOSE WHO HAVE BEEN AFFECTED.

3. A MULTI-SENSORY JOURNEY THROUGH THE GARDEN, WITH FOCUS ON ACCESSIBILITY

IN PRACTICE: COLOUR. SCENT. TEXTURE.
SHINGLES. SOUNDSCAPES. COTTAGE/SHELTER
AS A FINAL DESTINATION.

4. BRINGING THE EXHIBITION TO THE POCKET PARK, SYMBOLICALLY, COMBINES WATURE, ART, TEXT AND WORDS (SPOKEN OR WRITTEN)

IN PRACTICE: A SENSE OF JARMAN THROUGH THE GARDEN.

5. SPACE FOR REFLECTION AND REVELATION

IN PRACTICE: REFLECT (USE OF MIRRORS TO REFLECT WHAT IS IN THE GARDEN) & REVELATION (WHAT IS HIDDEN).

6. INSPIRES PEOPLE TO GARDEN AND TAKE ACTION FOR CLIMATE JUSTICE.

In practice: Sharing gardening & activist knowledge. Building in sustainability. Conserve water consumption, seeded roof on shelter and planting to encourage biodiversity

ZOOM ACTIVITY BY THE ARTIST JULIET: WHEN EVERYONE HAS READ THEIR PRINCIPLES, WE ALL VOTE USING DEMOCRACY: WE EACH GET A CERTAIN NUMBER OF 'DOTS' (COULD BE 3 OR 5 'X' (ROSSES) AND WE EACH ANONYMOUSLY TYPE A CROSS NEXT TO OUR TOP CHOICES. IF YOU ONLY HAVE ONE TOP CHOICE YOU CAN TYPE ALL YOUR CROSSES NEXT TO THAT ONE.

ONCE EVERYONE HAS VOTED WE COUNT WHICH PRINCIPLES HAVE THE MOST VOTES, THESE ARE THE ONES WE KEEP.





DEREK JARMAN THE ACTIVIST


JARMAN -1942-1994 WAS AND IS AN IMPORTANT PART OF LGBTQ+ HISTORY IN THE UK, SPEAKING OUT PUBLICLY FOR GAY RIGHTS AND FIGHTING HOMOPHOBIA THROUGHOUT HIS LIFE. PLONG WITH MANY OTHER GAY MEN IN THE 1980S & 90S, JARMAN WAS DIAGNOSED HIV POSITIVE AND DIED FROM AN RIDS-RELATED ILLNESS AT THE AGE OF 52.







FOUR TIMES IN 1988 WE BROKE THE RECORD FOR EUROPE'S LARGEST DEMONSTRATION 12,000;15000;20,000;25,000. WE LEARNT WHO OUR TRUE ALLIES WERE, AND OUR FAIR-WEATHER FRIENDS. THE LABOUR PARTY DESERTED US AT THE FIRST HURDLE. THE GUARDIAN TOLD US THAT CLAUSE 28 WAS OUR OWN FAULT. THE CLAUSE BECAME LAW-PLAYS BANNED, EXHIBITIONS STOPPED. TEACHERS SILENCED. BUT FOR WHAT? HAPPY CHRISTMAS MARGARET. -DEREK JARMAN, AT YOUR OWN RISK: A SAINT'S TESTAMENT, 1992

1946

JARMAN GIFTED THE BOOK BEAUTIFUL FLOWERS AND HOW TO GROW THEM BY HIS PARENTS, BEGINNING HIS LIFE-LONG LOVE OF GARDENS

From 1942 - 1950

THE JARMAN FAMILY LIVE IN ENGLAND, PAKISTAN AND ÎTALY, MOVING FOR JARMAN'S FATHER'S WORK AS A SERVING RAF OFFICER.

TIMELINE OF LGBT HISTORY IN MANCHESTER

EARLY 1940S

THE UNION PUB, NOW THE NEW UNION, PLAYS HOST TO DRAG SHOWS DURING WORLD WAR II. THEY WERE POPULAR WITH PAMERICAN TROOPS STATIONED WEARBY.

1952

PLAN TURING IS PROSECUTED FOR BEING IN A RELATIONSHIP WITH ANOTHER MAN. HE DIES BY SUICIDE IN 1954.

1960s

MANCHESTER'S GAY SCENE IS BASED IN AN AREA BETWEEN PLBERT SQUARE AND DEANSGATE WITH PUBS SUCH AS THE ROCKINGHAM AND ROUGE BEING POPULAR ALTHOUGH THE UNION CONTINUES TO BE FREQUENTED BY THE GAY COMMUNITY.

1964

THE NORTH WEST HOMOSEXUAL LAW
REFORM COMMITTEE IS FOUNDED BY
LABOUR COUNCILLOR FILLAN HORSFALL. THE
FIRST MEETING IS HELD IN MANCHESTER.

1967

Summer of Love. Homosexuality Decriminalised in England for Consenting Adults over 21.

1973

THE MANCHESTER GAY PLLIANCE IS FORMED

JARMAN WHIPPED AND SHAMED AT
HORDLE HOUSE FOR CUDDLING IN BED
WITH HIS FRIEND GAVIN, 'SOWING TERRIBLE
SEEDS OF DOUBT AND SELF-HATE'.

1955-60

JARMAN BEGINS GARDENING WITH CACTI IN THE GARDEN AT NORTHWOOD. YVES KLEIN PRESENTS HIS WORK: AN EMPTY WHITE ROOM ENTERED THROUGH A BLUE CURTAIN.

1963

HAVING COMPLETED HIS DEGREE IN ENGLISH AND HISTORY AT KING'S COLLEGE, JARMAN STARTED AT SLADE, STUDYING PAINTING AND SET DESIGN.

1967

Immediately after finishing at Slade, Jarman exhibits widely in London, Liverpool and Paris.

1970

DESIGNS THE SETS FOR KEN RUSSELL'S THE DEVILS, SHOT AT PINEWOOD STUDIOS.

1972

PUBLISHES POETRY COLLECTION & FINGER IN THE FISHES MOUTH

BEGINS PROLIFIC PRODUCTION OF SUPER8 FILMS. DESIGNS SETS AND PRODUCES PAINTINGS AND FURNITURE FOR KEN RUSSEL'S FILM SAVAGE MESSIAH.

BY THE UNIVERSITY'S LESDIAN & GAY SOCIETY, CHE, A LESDIAN GROUP AND TRANSVESTITE / TRANSSEXUAL GROUP.

1975

2 JANUARY - THE MANCHESTER GAY
RILIANCE OPENS THE MANCHESTER GAY
SWITCHBOARD TO PROVIDE SUPPORT AND
INFORMATION TO CALLERS. IT ORIGINALLY
OPERATED IN THE BASEMENT OF THE
UNIVERSITY OF MANCHESTER. BY 1990,
THE SWITCHBOARD TEAMED UP WITH
THE LESBIAN LINK HELPLINE TO FORM
THE MANCHESTER LESBIAN AND GAY
SWITCHBOARD.



1978

THE FIRST EDITION OF THE MANCUNIAN GAY MAGAZINE IS PUBLISHED.

<u> 1979</u>

MARGARET THATCHER ELECTED PRIME MINISTER.

1984

MANCHESTER CITY COUNCIL FORMS THE EQUAL OPPORTUNITIES COMMITTEE.

RELEASES FIRST FEATURE FILM, SEBASTIANE, IN SARDINIA. A QUEER RETELLING OF THE MARTYRDOM OF ST. SEBASTIAN, THE FILM IS NOTABLE FOR ITS HOMO-EROTICISM AND ENTIRELY LATIN DIALOGUE.

1977

Makes Britain's 'FIRST PUNK FILM'
JUBILEE. FEATURING ELIZABETH I TIME-TRAVELLING TO 705 BRITAIN. MAKES
MUSIC VIDEO FOR SEX PISTOLS.

1979

MAKES THE TEMPEST, A RETELLING OF SHAKESPEARE'S PLAY. MAKES BROKEN ENGLISH SUITE OF 3 MUSIC VIDEOS FOR MARIANNE FAITHFUL.

1986

Nominated for the Turner Prize
for his contribution to film. Makes
Caravaggio. Meets Keith Collins,
Jarman's companion until his death.
In December, Jarman is diagnosed as
HIV-positive.

1987

BUYS PROSPECT COTTAGE WITH HIS INHERITANCE FROM HIS FATHER. DIRECTS VIDEO FOR PET SHOP BOYS IT'S A SIN. MAKES LAST OF ENGLAND.

1988

BEGINS WORKING EXTENSIVELY FOR RIGHTS FOR GAY PEOPLE AND RIDS SUFFERERS.

1985

MANCHESTER PRIDE IS BORN FOLLOWING A £1,700 GRANT FROM THE MANCHESTER CITY COUNCIL TO PUT ON A TWO-WEEK CELEBRATION, COMPLETE WITH A HUGE BANNER ADORNING OXFORD STREET.

1986

EUROPE'S FIRST PURPOSE-BUILT GAY CENTRE BUILT IN MANCHESTER.



1988

SECTION 28, PASSED INTO LAW PROHIBITING LOCAL AUTHORITIES AND SCHOOLS FROM "PROMOTING" HOMOSEXUALITY AND PREVENTED COUNCILS FROM FUNDING MUCHNEEDED LESBIAN AND GAY INITIATIVES AT A TIME WHEN GAY PEOPLE WERE STRUGGLING TO COPE WITH THE RIDS EPIDEMIC.

H HUGE ANTI-SECTION 28 PROTEST IS HELD IN MANCHESTER.

1989

THE NORTHWEST CAMPAIGN FOR LESDIAN & GAY FQUALITY ORGANISES MANCHESTER'S "CELEBRATION OF GAY AND LESDIAN DIVERSITY".

MAKES WAR REQUIEM.

1990

MAKES THE GARDEN.

1991

PUBLISHES MODERN NATURE. CANONISED AS ST. DEREK OF DUNGENESS BY THE SISTERS OF PERPETUAL INDULGENCE. MAKES EDWARD II.

1992

Publishes At Your Own Risk. Queer, an exhibition of New Paintings including large 'slogan' works at Manchester Art Gallery.

1443

MAKES WITTGENSTEIN. MAKES HIS LAST FEATURE FILM BLUE. DIRECTS MUSIC VIDEOS FOR SUEDE, PET SHOP BOYS AND PATTI SMITH.

1994

RELEASES CHROMA. EVIL QUEEN: THE LAST PAINTINGS EXHIBITION AT WHITWORTH FIRT GALLERY, MANCHESTER.



WHEN I WAS ABOUT 8 I MET A BOY FROM AROUND THE CORNER FROM ME WHO BECAME A LIFE LONG FRIEND AND THERE WAS ALSO MY SECOND COUSIN TOO AND THE THREE OF US USED TO HANG AROUND TOGETHER.

WE ALL FELT WE WERE DIFFERENT AND ALTHOUGH WE LIKED GIRLS WE WERE ATTRACTED SEXUALLY TO THE SAME SEX. I THINK I WAS LUCKY REALLY TO BE IN THIS SMALL GROUP AS WE ALL WERE THERE TO SUPPORT ONE ANOTHER THROUGH OUR TEENAGE YEARS.



LATER WHEN I WAS ABOUT IG AND WORKING AT THE POST OFFICE I MET A GAY TRAFFIC WARDEN AND IT WAS HE WHO ACTUALLY INTRODUCED ME TO THE GAY SCENE. I LEFT HOME NOT LONG AFTER MY MOTHER PASSED AWAY FROM CANCER WHEN I WAS 17. MY DAD MARRIED AGAIN AND HE WAS OF THE VICTORIAN MINDSET AND I DON'T THINK HE COULD ACCEPT ME BEING GAY.- DAVID

MINDY'S STORY

When I came out in 1980s I knew my chance of having children and my career would be affected, and I loved my career and I wanted to have children... Rnd the promise I made to myself is that I'd never walk round anybody, anybody, on the subject of my sexuality, because I'd already paid my price...I was actually a bloody good teacher.

IN 1983, I WAS IN HOSPITAL FOR CERVICAL CANCER SURGERY, AND WHILST I WAS ON THE WARD ANOTHER LESDIAN CAME IN.

THREE MONTHS AFTER I LEFT HOSPITAL SHE TURNED UP AT A PARTY AT MY HOUSE AND SAID THAT I HAD MADE THINGS EASIER FOR HER BECAUSE I OUTED MYSELF AND OPENED



WINDOW.

HER LIFE WAS EASIER BECAUSE OF ME. SHE WAS JUST THE SECOND LESBIAN OF THE WARD...IF YOU ARE IN A POSITION TO DO SOMETHING THAT ALLOWS OTHER PEOPLE TO WALK BEHIND YOU THEN DO IT... MY MESSAGE FOR PEOPLE COMING OUT NOW? ENJOY.

It's easier; it's not even a thing. Younger generations just don't get the division; 'what's all this labelling about? On the other hand, when it was all in the closet you got that thing about joining a secret club, with secret jewellery, like the labrys.

IN THE EARLY 90S I DISCOVERED I'D BEEN OUSTED TO THE POINT I COULDN'T GET A JOB, THAT'S WHY I MOVED TO MANCHESTER. I MOVED TO MANCHESTER BECAUSE I HAD FRIENDS HERE AND I KNEW THAT MANCHESTER WAS A GAY-FRIENDLY CITY. - MINDY

LABRYS: IN THE 1970S, THE LABRYS WAS ADOPTED BY THE LESDIAN COMMUNITY AS A LESDIAN FEMINIST SYMBOL REPRESENTING STRENGTH AND SELF-SUFFICIENCY.

HAZEL'S STORY

THINGS I HAVE LEARNT ABOUT DEREK JARMAN AND HIS GARDEN

I CAN TELL YOU THAT DEREK JARMAN LOVED HIS GARDEN. HE NEVER SET OUT TO START A GARDEN. IT WAS AN ACCIDENTAL GARDEN.

SEA KALE, GORSE, CISTUS, SALVIA, FENNEL AND POPPIES. HE FOUND THE RIGHT PLACE FOR EACH PLANT SO THAT IT COULD THRIVE IN THE SHINGLE THAT IS DUNGENESS. HE FELT THAT HE SHOULD HAVE BEEN A GARDENER ALL ALONG.

I CAN TELL YOU HOW HE SEEMED TRADITIONAL AND YET HIS WORK WAS RADICAL, HOW HIS GARDEN WAS OUTWARD-LOOKING YET CONTEMPLATIVE, VAST YET INTIMATE, WILD YET PRECISE. I CAN TELL YOU THAT HIS GARDEN HAS NO BOUNDARIES OTHER THAN THE HORIZON, AND HOW THE HUMMING OF DUNGENESS B MIXES WITH THE SEA BREEZE.

I can tell you how he raged with fury at the way in which his generation of gay men was treated. How they died painful deaths and in many cases, lonely, estranged from their families. But also, how they belonged to their own chosen families, even if they didn't all get on. I can tell you that Derek Jarman didn't identify with the Stonewall people or Cashman or some of the other media gays.

I CAN'T TELL YOU WHAT DEREK JARMAN FELT ABOUT HIS TOO-SOON DEATH OR LEAVING HIS FRIENDS OR THE PLACES AND PEOPLE HE LOVED. OR LEAVING HIS GARDEN. I'M NOT EVEN SURE THAT HE WOULD LIKE WHAT WE'RE DOING IN MANCHESTER, CREATING A GARDEN ALL ABOUT HIM.

HE NEVER WANTED A PANEL ON THE RIDS AUILT, IN FACT HE SAID HE WOULD 'HAUNT' ANYONE WHO MADE ONE FOR HIM. SO WHAT WILL HE THINK OF OUR GARDEN, INSPIRED BY HIM AND HIS HOME AT PROSPECT COTTAGE, INSPIRED BY HIS REFUSAL TO BE SILENCED BY THE STATUS QUO, INSPIRED BY HIS INSISTENCE THAT LOVE IS A HUMAN RIGHT FOR US ALL?

HAZEL'S THOUGHTS ON JARMAN'S LINES

"I walk in this garden holding the hands of dead friends. Old age came quickly to my frosted generation, cold, cold, cold, they died so silently."

The outrage, sadness, bewilderment and loss of young men dying too soon.

Leaving behind their dignity, bravery, fury and witness, we have the privilege of loving who we want and growing old.

"Up hill, down dale we go to Prospect Cottage, which grows like a tree – more beautiful as it ages."

PAUL'S STORY

IN THE SUMMER OF 2020, DURING A BRIEF BREAK FROM COVID LOCKDOWN, I VISITED THE SOUTH COAST FOR A WEEK WITH A FRIEND. ONE HOT SUMMER'S DAY WE CYCLED FROM RYE OUT TO DUNGENESS. THROUGH THE WIDE FLAT EXPANSES OF ROMNEY MARSH AND THE PRETTY VILLAGE OF LYDD BEFORE EMERGING OUT ONTO THE SURREAL LANDSCAPE OF DUNGENESS.

I WAS COMPLETELY MESMERISED BY THIS 'OTHER WORLDLY' PLACE, A VAST LANDSCAPE WITH NO HORIZON AND DOMINATED BY A NUCLEAR POWER STATION, NOT SOMETHING YOU COULD CALL BEAUTIFUL BUT YET THERE WAS SOMETHING MAGICAL ABOUT THE RAWNESS AND SIMPLICITY OF THE ENVIRONMENT.

WE HAD GONE TO SEE DEREK JARMAN'S COTTAGE AND GARDEN ALTHOUGH AT THE TIME I DIDN'T KNOW THAT MUCH ABOUT HIM. I INSTANTLY FELL IN LOVE WITH THE BLACK TAR COTTAGE, IT'S SIMPLE AND GEOMETRIC SHAPE AND YELLOW FRAMED WINDOWS SURROUNDED BY A GARDEN CONTAINING ARCHITECTURAL ELEMENTS OF THE SEA. AS AN ENTHUSIASTIC AMATEUR GARDENER, I MARVELLED AT HOW ANYONE COULD GROW PLANTS IN THIS INHOSPITABLE LANDSCAPE AND THAT'S WHEN I BEGAN TO READ AND DISCOVER ABOUT JARMAN THE GARDENER AND DIARIST.

THROUGH MY INVOLVEMENT IN THIS PROJECT, I'VE STARTED TO LEARN SO MUCH MORE ABOUT DEREK JARMAN: JARMAN THE GARDENER, WRITER, ARTIST, POET, FILM MAKER, AS WELL AS HIS ACTIVISM FOR LGBT RIGHTS AND HIS VERY PERSONAL BUT PUBLIC BATTLE WITH HIV AND RIDS.

WE ARE A SMALL GROUP OF VOLUNTEERS, AMATEUR BUT ENTHUSIASTIC GARDENERS, ALL WITH OUR OWN CONNECTION TO JARMAN AND IT'S BEEN FASCINATING AND A PRIVILEGE TO HEAR THEIR STORIES. THE LANDSCAPE OF MANCHESTER CITY CENTRE IS AS INHOSPITABLE AS DUNGENESS! - PAUL

DO WORDS MATTER? 'QUEER ELDERS', LGBTQ+ IDENTITY, AND INTERGENERATIONAL CONVERSATIONS

THE COLLECTIVE IS KEEN TO TALK ABOUT HOW THINGS HAVE CHANGED FOR LGBTQ+ COMMUNITY, AND USE OF TERMINOLOGY, LIKE 'QUEER':

"Younger people say that gay people have reclaimed the word."

"WHO ARE THESE PEOPLE?"

"TO ME QUEER WAS LIKE VERY OFFENSIVE AT SCHOOL. IT HAS TAKEN ME A LOT TO GET USED TO IT."

"It's so common-place now; EVERYTHING IS QUEER."

"I (AN'T UNDERSTAND WHY IT HAS BECOME SO POPULARISED."

"I THINK IT IS BECAUSE IT ALLOWS PEOPLE WHO ARE HETEROSEXUAL WHO CAN ACTUALLY BE INCLUDED AS QUEER. It'S BECOME A VERY INCLUSIVE TERM; YOU DON'T HAVE TO BE A PRACTICING HOMOSEXUAL TO LABEL YOURSELF QUEER."

"I THOUGHT IT HAD BEEN RECLAIMED IN THE 80s AND THAT WAS IT, DONE, LIKE DYKE. MY WIFE DOESN'T LIKE THE WORD DYKE."

"Dyke, I think that's offensive as well. If you said to a lesbian 'you're a Dyke', that would be like insulting her." "TITLING THE SHOW, HOWEVER, WAS A GROUP DECISION. ORIGINALLY TITLED "SHIPWRECKED"
-AN OBLIQUE DIARY REFERENCE FROM DEREK DESCRIBING 'A CESSPIT AT THE HEART OF MANCHESTER' THE TITLE WAS SOON AFTER DECLARED AS 'QUEER'.

RUDACIOUS, BLATANT, INTENTIONALLY
PROVOCATIVE, WE HAD MANY SERIOUS
CONVERSATIONS, WHICH WERE NEVERTHELESS
LACED WITH HUMOUR DUE TO THEIR
ABSURDITY, AS TO WHETHER DEREK
JRMAN QUEER OR QUEER DEREK
JRMAN WAS THE MOST APPROPRIATE
WORD ORDER FOR THE PUBLICITY BANNERS.

BUT THE TITLE WAS NOT WITHOUT CONTENTION. I WAS INVITED TO THE OFFICE OF A PROMINENT COUNCILLOR WHO, WHILST STATING (ATEGORICALLY HIS SUPPORT FOR THE SHOW, DREW MY ATTENTION TO THE FACT THAT THE OPENING DATE WAS THE WEEK FOLLOWING THE LOCAL ELECTIONS, WHICH WERE SCHEDULED FOR THE SEVENTH OF MAY.

I WAS ADVISED NOT TO USE THE TITLE 'QUEER' BEFORE THE ELECTION DATE."

So, words do matter... below, some examples of a helpful LGBTQ+ glossary produced by the National Museums Liverpool

COMING OUT

Short for 'coming out of the closet', The phrase is used to describe a person Telling others they are gay, lesdian, Disexual, Trans or Queer.

INTERSECTIONALITY

RICKNOWLEDGES THAT A PERSON'S IDENTITY IS INFORMED BY THEIR GENDER, SEXUALITY, RACE, CLASS AND ABILITY, AMONGST OTHER THINGS, AND THAT THEIR EXPERIENCES OF OPPRESSION WILL BE INFLUENCED ACCORDINGLY.

GENDER

GENDER REFERS TO THE SOCIALLY
CONSTRUCTED CHARACTERISTICS OF WOMEN
AND MEN. IT VARIES FROM SOCIETY TO
SOCIETY AND CAN BE CHANGED.

BACK IN THE DAY I WOULDN'T HAVE ANYONE CALL ME GIRL, OR LADY. A WOMAN IS GOOD ENOUGH! LESBIANS WERE SO ANGRY ABOUT EVERYTHING. FEMINISM AND LGBT RIGHTS, IT WAS A DOUBLE WHAMMY, LESBIANS WERE DESPISED BY EVERYBODY IN THE SAME WAY THAT BEING CAMP FOR MEN WAS DESPISED, IT WAS LIKE LOWERING YOURSELF, IT WAS ALL VERY PATRIARCHAL. ALL THIS HAS MOVED ON. BUT I SAY TO THE YOUNG ONES, IF YOU REALLY FEEL YOU'VE GOT THE RIGHT WORD, THE RIGHT POLITICAL ANALYSIS. ENJOY YOURSELF BECAUSE IT WON'T LAST. - MINDY

I was mortified when a radio host announced me as a Queer Elder. I have always found this terminology derogatory. Having grown up in the 50s 60s where it was a very regular occurrence being called queer. I was never queer. I was an individual discovering who and what I was. What I find incomprehensible is that it seems on trend to use this as recognition as being gay LGBT... I just wonder how many other elders are affected by the terminology.

As I SAID IT JUST SEEMS TO BE BANDIED AROUND NOW AS A NORMAL PART OF OUR VOCABULARY. IT ALMOST FEELS LIKE WE'RE THE LOST GENERATION AND NOT TAKEN INTO CONSIDERATION WHEN THESE DECISIONS ARE MADE. — PHILIP

INTERGENERATIONAL CONVERSATIONS

WHEN I WAS LITTLE THERE WERE TWO KINDS OF PEOPLE, BOYS AND GIRLS AND YOU DIDN'T SWAP TEAMS, THERE WERE STRAIGHT MEN AND THERE WERE STRAIGHT WOMEN AND THAT WAS IT THAT WAS THE WORLD I GREW UP IN AND EVENTUALLY I BEGAN TO REALISE THAT THAT WASN'T THE WHOLE TRUTH OF IT. SO WE'VE MOVED ON.

MY CURRENT THINKING IS, BINARY IS GREAT FOR COMPUTERS, ZEROS AND ONE, GREAT FOR COMPUTERS IT DOESN'T EXPRESS THE COMPLEXITY OF HUMAN PEOPLE AND THE WAY I SEE IT IS ... I BELIEVE IN EVOLUTION AND I THINK THE FACT THAT LGBT FOLK ARE STILL IN EXISTENCE SHOWS THAT WE ARE NECESSARY TO THE EVOLUTION OF OUR SPECIES BECAUSE IF WE WEREN'T WE WOULD HAVE BEEN BRED OUT OF EXISTENCE LONG SINCE BECAUSE ITS ONLY RECENTLY THAT WE HAVE BEEN HAVING CHILDREN.

PHILIP AND I LAUGH ABOUT THE FACT THAT BACK IN THE DAY, WE WOULD NOT HAVE SPOKEN TO EACH OTHER, IN THE 80'S LESBIANS AND GAY MEN DIDN'T GET ON. BUT NOW, WE AS A GROUP ARE COOPERATING AND COLLABORATING.

H VISITOR TO THE POCKET PARK ALSO TALKED ABOUT THE IMPORTANCE OF INTERGENERATIONAL CONVERSATIONS:

I SAW THE PROTEST! EXHIBITION A COUPLE OF TIMES, AND IT GIVES PEOPLE FOOD FOR THOUGHT. HE HAS LAID DOWN FOUNDATIONS FOR THE FUTURE OF LGBT AND THIS GARDEN IS ALSO REPRESENTING LGBT. RITHOUGH WE'VE COME A LONG WAY WE STILL HAVE A LONG WAY TO GO - AND DEREK JARMAN GIVES US THE PUSH FOR THAT. IF THERE'S STILL PEOPLE WHO ARE ANTI-GAY, WHICH THERE WILL ALWAYS BE, WE CAN TRY AND MAKE PEOPLE MORE AWARE. LGBT HISTORY LIKE THE RIDS PANDEMIC FOR EXAMPLE - CHILDREN NEED TO LEARN ABOUT THIS HISTORY AT SCHOOL.

THE SPACE CAN BE USED TO EDUCATE AND INFORM, AND ENCOURAGE THOSE WHO DON'T KNOW ABOUT JARMAN AND HIS CAMPAIGNS AND THE FIGHT FOR EQUALITY. ÎT'S A SPACE TO BRING PEOPLE TOGETHER TO TELL THIS STORY. ÎT CAN BE FULLY INTERGENERATIONAL.

While sitting in the park a conversation started on The Last of England, & Derek Jarman film that came out in 1988, and other films:

LEWIS: I LIKE THE WAY THE FILM FLITS BETWEEN CHILDHOOD AND ADULTHOOD, IT'S THE SAME PERSON TRYING TO CLING ONTO THE INNOCENCE OF BEING A CHILD AND NOT HAVING THAT FEAR OF JUDGEMENT. IT'S INTERESTING THAT WITH IT BEING FROM 1988 THIS FILM HAS LINKS TO THATCHER ERA BRITAIN AND SECTION 28.

PHILIP: DID YOU KNOW THAT YEAR

MANCHESTER HAD THE LARGEST PROTEST

MARCH, THE CLAUSE 28 ONE, IN THE WHOLE

OF EUROPE AT THAT TIME - OVER 25,000

PEOPLE TURNED UP?

LEWIS: WHICH OTHER FAMOUS DIRECTORS OR HOBBYISTS WHO MAKE FILM COME TO YOUR MIND?

MINDY: SIOBHAN FAHEY AND HARRI SHANAHAN WHO MADE THE DOCUMENTARY 'REBEL DYKES' - CHECK THEM OUT!

PHILIP: WORKS BY JOE ORTON
WHICH WERE ADAPTED FOR SCREEN
- 'ENTERTAINING MR SLOANE' FOR
EXAMPLE AND 'PRICK UP YOUR EARS'
ABOUT HIS LIFE. HE WAS SO GREAT AT
PORTRAYING 'GAYNESS' AND LIFE OF
THE GAY COMMUNITY AT THAT TIME IN
STARK, DARK REALITY - WHILST BEING
HILARIOUS AND RELATABLE, BUT HAVING
SERIOUS SIDE. FIND THESE FILMS ARE
A WHOLE CHUNK OF OUR GAY HISTORY
WHICH NO ONE IS TALKING ABOUT. WHAT
COMES TO MIND FOR YOU LEWIS?



LEWIS: 'NEW QUEER CINEMA' IS A SUBCULTURE OF UNDERGROUND, EXPERIMENTAL FILMS -AND WASN'T COINED UNTIL THE EARLY 905. MANY OF THESE FILMMAKERS SEEMED HEAVILY INFLUENCED BY THE WORK OF JARMAN. GREGG BRAKI IS THE FIRST PERSON THAT COMES TO MIND WHEN I THINK OF NEW QUEER CINEMA. THERE WAS A NIHILISTIC, PUNK/GRUNGE ATTITUDE UNDERLYING ALL OF HIS FILMS (ESPECIALLY IN THE 905), WITH POLITICAL OPPRESSION FELT BY REBELLIOUS GROUPS OF LGBT TEENS BEING A KEY THEME LINKING THE FILMS. I THINK THIS WAS SPURRED ON BY THE FALLOUT FROM THE HIV/RIDS CRISIS - IGNITING UNREST WITHIN THE COMMUNITY.

RRAKI'S SMALL-TEAM, LOW-BUDGET MOVIES WERE ESSENTIALLY A MIDDLE-FINGER TO MAINSTREAM CULTURE, AND DEFINITELY OFFERED A SENSE OF BELONGING AND UNDERSTANDING FOR MANY LATE TEENS/ EARLY TWENTIES QUEER PEOPLE OUT THERE AT THAT TIME, AND EVEN NOW! THIS UNDERGROUND COLLECTIVE OF FILMS HAS COME FULL-CIRCLE AND IS BEING APPRECIATED AND UNDERSTOOD BY QUEER PEOPLE IN 2023, JUST AS THEY WERE IN LATE 90S - I BELIEVE THAT'S THE DEFINITION OF TIMELESS.



DIFFERENT VOICES FROM VISITORS

TO THE PARK HELP US PUT THIS

CONVERSATION INTO PERSPECTIVE:

I came to the exhibition of Derek Jarman's work 20 years ago here. Rnd met him at that time as he was here in Manchester. The exhibition was called 'Queer' and it was really controversial at the time to use that word and have it displayed outside.

It's still controversial now for the older generation – not everybody but for some. The current Protest! exhibition which has been here recently is more acceptable but Derek Jarman's life was all about protest as far as I can understand and there's still things to do – countries around the world where people can be killed just for being gay. It's really important that we have these protests, these exhibitions and this garden will help to show us more what Jarman did.

I SAW THE PROTEST! EXHIBITION A COUPLE OF TIMES, AND IT GIVES PEOPLE FOOD FOR THOUGHT.

HE HAS LAID DOWN FOUNDATIONS FOR THE FUTURE OF LGBT AND THIS GARDEN IS ALSO REPRESENTING LGBT. RITHOUGH WE'VE COME A LONG WAY WE STILL HAVE A LONG WAY TO GO — AND DEREK JARMAN GIVES US THE PUSH FOR THAT. IF THERE'S STILL PEOPLE WHO ARE ANTI-GAY, WHICH THERE WILL ALWAYS BE, WE CAN TRY AND MAKE PEOPLE MORE AWARE. LGBT HISTORY LIKE THE RIDS PANDEMIC FOR EXAMPLE — CHILDREN NEED TO LEARN ABOUT THIS HISTORY AT SCHOOL.

The space can be used to educate and inform, and encourage those who don't know about Jarman and his campaigns and the fight for equality. It's a space to bring people together to tell this story. It can be fully intergenerational.

UTTLE GREEN OASIS, THE DEREK JARMAN
POCKET GARDEN AT MANCHESTER BRT
GALLERY, WE TOOK THE OPPORTUNITY TO
VISIT SOME GREEN SPACES IN AND AROUND
MANCHESTER. OUR VISITS INCLUDED PLACES
REFLECTING THE LGBTQ+ COMMUNITY'S
STRUGGLE FOR RECOGNITION AND RIGHTS
AS WELL AS PLACES OFFERING A MUCH
NEEDED BREATHING SPACE WITHIN OUR CITY
ALONG WITH HOPE FOR THE FUTURE OF OUR
ENVIRONMENT.

OUR FIRST VISIT AT THE END OF MAY 2021 WAS QUITE MOMENTOUS AS WE WERE ABLE TO MEET EACH OTHER IN PERSON FOR THE FIRST TIME AFTER MONTHS OF ZOOM MEETINGS.

WE MET AT SACKVILLE GARDENS, WHICH SEEMED THE BEST PLACE TO START AS ONE OF THE MOST WELL-KNOWN GREEN SPACES IN THE CITY LINKED TO THE LGBTQ+
COMMUNITY.



PART FROM ENJOYING THE PEACEFUL GREEN SPACE, WE TOOK OUR TIME TO ADMIRE THE VERY FIRST STATUE AND MEMORIAL FOR FLAN TURING AND TO REFLECT ON THE NATIONAL TRANSGENDER REMEMBRANCE MEMORIAL, AND THE BEACON OF HOPE MEMORIAL. WE ALSO VISITED THE COMMUNAL GARDEN AT THE GRADE II LISTED BUILDING VICTORIA SQUARE IN ANCOATS, WHICH WAS THE FIRST MUNICIPAL HOUSING BUILT IN MANCHESTER IN 1894 AND NOW HOUSES AROUND ITO OLDER PEOPLE. PETER, WHO IS A RESIDENT AT VICTORIA SQUARE, SHOWED US ROUND AND TOLD US THE STORY OF THE LATE DAME GRACY, THEIR GARDENER FOR SEVERAL YEARS.



LOWRY), ROSIE NAYLOR FROM RHS BRIDGEWATER AND MIRANDA CLARKE FROM CITY OF TREES SHOWED US THE FANTASTIC WORK THE IGNITION LIVING LAB IS UNDERTAKING AT SALFORD UNIVERSITY.



THE VISIONER'S VISION



LAWRIE IS CALLED THE VISIONER FOR A FEW REASONS, NOT LEAST FOR HIS ABILITY TO CREATE SIGHTS OUT OF WORDS, AS SEEN IN HIS DESCRIPTION OF ONE OF OUR PERIPATETIC ENCOUNTERS.

HE TOOK THE COLLECTIVE
AROUND SECRET GREEN SPACES IN
MANCHESTER GIVING US ALL FOOD
FOR THOUGHT AND INSIGHTS INTO
NATURE FOR INSPIRATION.

TO HAVE HAD THE OPPORTUNITY TO WORK ON A NEW POCKET PARK FOR THE PEOPLE OF MANCHESTER HAS BEEN SUCH AN INCREDIBLE EXPERIENCE, BUT THE FACT THAT THIS GARDEN HAS BEEN DESIGNED AND PLANTED BY A GROUP OF VOLUNTEER GARDENERS FROM OUR OVER 50S LGBTQ+ COMMUNITIES IN GREATER MANCHESTER MAKES IT A REALLY SPECIAL ACHIEVEMENT.

THE GARDENERS ARE OF A SIMILAR GENERATION TO DEREK JARMAN, AND THERE HAS BEEN MUCH REFLECTION ON THE IMPORTANCE OF HIS WORK IN RAISING THE VISIBILITY OF ISSUES FACING LGBT COMMUNITIES, AS WELL AS HIS POWERFUL EXPRESSION OF IDENTITY THROUGH HIS WORK. UNFORTUNATELY THIS GENERATION OF LGBT PEOPLE ARE NOW FACING A LACK OF VISIBILITY BOTH WITHIN LGBT COMMUNITIES AND WIDER SOCIETY, AND MANY ARE FACING GREATER LEVELS OF

ISOLATION DUE TO BEING LESS LIKELY TO HAVE CHILDREN AND A LACK OF CONNECTION TO FAMILY (WHO MAY HAVE OSTRACISED THEM DUE TO THEIR LGBT IDENTITY) ALONG WITH DISCRIMINATION IN HOUSING AND CARE SPACES. WE REALLY WANTED THIS GARDEN TO BE A RECOGNITION OF THEIR LIVES AND CONTRIBUTION TO SOCIETY, RUNNING IN PARALLEL WITH THE CELEBRATION OF DEREK JARMAN'S LIFE AND WORKS IN THE MAIN EXHIBITION SPACES.

LGBT FOUNDATION EXISTS TO CONTINUE

THE CURATOR'S VISION

"The exhibition Derek Jarman Protest! came about through a contact with the writer and broadcaster Jon Savage, who knew Jarman. We contacted the gallerist Amanda Wilkinson, who is part of the Keith Collins Will Trust (who oversee Jarman's estate and the existing works that are not in public or private collections).

RMANDA HAD ALREADY BEGUN DISCUSSIONS WITH IMMR IN DUBLIN ABOUT A JARMAN RETROSPECTIVE, AND SEAN KISSANE THERE HAD ALREADY DONE QUITE A LOT OF RESEARCH. LUCKILY, IMMR WERE OPEN TO WORKING IN PARTNERSHIP, SO PROTEST! WAS BORN. WITH JON'S INVOLVEMENT, WE INCLUDED MORE OF A FOCUS ON JARMAN'S CONNECTION WITH ACTIVISM, PUNK AND POPULAR CULTURE HERE IN MANCHESTER, THERE WAS ALSO A STRONG FOCUS ON THE GARDEN AT DUNGENESS.

When we were planning the exhibition we wanted to think about what Jarman's work meant to people today, and what he might be doing if he was here with us. Lawrie and I had discussions about the Pride in Reeing group, how we could connect and what would matter to them.

JARMAN HAD A GROUND-BREAKING
EXHIBITION AT MRG IN 1992 CALLED QUEER
AND WE OWN THE TITULAR PAINTING. HE WAS
IMPRESSED BY THE CITY AND OUR HISTORY OF
PROTEST AND CHALLENGING AUTHORITY. MANY
OF THE THINGS THAT JARMAN PROTESTED OR
CAMPAIGNED FOR RESONATED WITH AND WERE
RELEVANT TO THE PRIDE IN RGEING GROUP.

WE MET THE ADVISORY GROUP TO DISCUSS WHETHER THEY WANTED TO WORK WITH US AND WHAT WOULD BE IMPORTANT TO THEM. ONE IDEA WAS TO CREATE A GARDEN SPACE INSPIRED BY JARMAN'S PASSION FOR HIS GARDEN AT DUNGENESS.

MANY MEMBERS OF THE GROUP SEIZED UPON THAT IDEA. IT BIG PART OF THAT DECISION WAS THE IMPORTANCE OF RAISING VISIBILITY OF LGBT+ OLDER PEOPLE. WE ALSO TALKED ABOUT WHAT JARMAN WOULD HAVE BEEN CONCERNED ABOUT TODAY AND WE IMAGINED THAT HE WOULD HAVE FOUGHT FOR CLIMATE JUSTICE.

HAVING THE OPPORTUNITY TO RECONNECT WITH THE LGBT+ COMMUNITY IN MANCHESTER TO CREATE THE DEREK JARMAN POCKET PARK GAVE US THE OPPORTUNITY TO HIGHLIGHT JARMAN'S PASSION FOR GARDENING (SOMETHING THAT WAS DIFFICULT TO COMMUNICATE IN THE EXHIBITION ITSELF) AND CREATE A LASTING TRIBUTE TO HIM HERE IN THE CITY WHERE HE HELD HIS FINAL EXHIBITIONS.

THE PROJECTS HAVE NOW LED TO THE ACQUISITION OF TWO ADDITIONAL ARTWORKS BY JARMAN FOR THE CITY'S COLLECTION, WHICH WILL HELP US REFLECT FURTHER ON LGBT+ HISTORY AND TELL NEW STORIES. THE GARDEN HAS BEEN AN IMPORTANT PLACE FOR BRINGING PEOPLE TOGETHER (VOLUNTEERS AND THE WIDER COMMUNITY), DEVELOPING OUR KNOWLEDGE ABOUT JARMAN, ACTIVISM AND CUMATE CHANGE. WE LOOK FORWARD TO BUILDING MORE FRIENDSHIPS, PARTNERSHIPS AND POSITIVE IMPACTS AS THE GARDEN GROWS."

THE ARTIST'S

VISION

I REALLY APPRECIATED TAKING PART IN THE PROJECT AS A FACILITATING ARTIST, TO SUPPORT THE GROUP TO CO-PRODUCE THE GARDEN: DE-CENTERING FROM MY OWN CREATIVE DECISIONS, BRINGING MY ONLINE/OFFLINE GROUP FACILITATION SKILLS WITH AN ECOLOGICAL FOCUS TO SUPPORT THE GROUP IN MAKING DECISIONS.

WE STARTED THE PROJECT IN JUNE

2020 AND WORKED ONLINE THROUGHOUT
SUMMER, RUTUMN AND WINTER. R LOT
OF THAT TIME WAS SPENT IN LOCKDOWN
AND MOST OF US DIDN'T KNOW EACH
OTHER BEFORE THE PROJECT, SO WE TOOK
EXTRA CARE TO CREATE WAYS TO CHECK-IN
-AND CHECK-OUT WHICH EACH OTHER, GET
TO KNOW EACH OTHER AS PEOPLE AND
OUR RELATION TO JARMAN, SO WE COULD
BUILD A COMMON GROUND DESPITE BEING
PHYSICALLY ISOLATED FROM EACH OTHER.

ONE OF THE MAIN THINGS I'M TAKING AWAY IS THE NEED FOR MORE INTERGENERATIONAL LGBT EXCHANGES. IT WAS AN IMMENSE PRIVILEGE TO HOLD SPACE FOR LGBT PEOPLE OF OLDER GENERATIONS WHO WERE FIGHTING FOR FREEDOM WHEN I WASN'T BORN OR VERY YOUNG, AND WHO HAD VERY DIFFERENT LIFE EXPERIENCES FROM MINE.

ONE PARTICULAR ASPECT IS THE CONVERSATIONS AROUND LANGUAGE: I IDENTIFY WITH THE WORD 'QUEER' IN ITS VERSATILITY AS A VERB/ADJECTIVE AND ITS COMMITMENT TO QUESTIONING; THIS WORD ALSO HAS PAINFUL CONNOTATIONS



FOR OLDER PEOPLE WHO REMEMBER IT BEING USED AS A SLUR AGAINST THEM, SOMETHING I WAS UNAWARE OF WHEN I MOVED TO THE UK. THIS IS SOMETHING I HAVE TAKEN FORWARD IN EVENT DESCRIPTIONS, USING BOTH 'LGBTQ+' AND 'QUEER' WHEN THINKING ABOUT MAKING THE SPACES MORE ACCESSIBLE TO SEVERAL GENERATIONS, NOT JUST MINE - JULIET.



THE HORTICULTURALIST'S VISION



I MET LAWRIE IN 2019, WHEN WE STARTED TO TALK ABOUT SOME IDEAS, THEN WHEN I JOINED THE PROJECT LATER IT WAS A REALLY EXCITING WAY OF CONTINUING ON THAT DISCUSSION, GOING ON JOURNEYS WITH PEOPLE. WE ALL MET ONLINE FIRST, BUT TO MEET EVERYONE IN REAL LIFE MADE ME SEE HOW IT ALL FITS TOGETHER. THE GARDENING SESSIONS HAVE BEEN FASCINATING BECAUSE PEOPLE HAVE DIFFERENT TAKES ON THE PROJECT. BECAUSE WE ALL LOVE PLANTS. BUT SOME SUPPORT THE ENVIRONMENTAL MOVEMENT, OTHERS HAVE ARTISTIC AND CREATIVE DIRECTIONS; EVERYONE BRINGING DIFFERENT PERSPECTIVES. THE FACT THAT A GARDEN, A PUBLIC SOCIAL SPACE, CAN BE ALL THOSE THINGS, IT'S VERY EXCITING.

I'M GAY AND I HAVEN'T ALWAYS HAD MUCH OPPORTUNITY TO SPEND TIME WITH OTHER LGBT GENERATIONS; IT'S BEEN IMPORTANT TO ME TO LEARN ABOUT THEIR, AND OUR COMMUNITY'S, PAST EXPERIENCES. I KNEW DEREK JARMAN AS A GARDENER AND QUEER ACTIVIST, BUT THEY BROUGHT SO MUCH MORE MEANING TO IT. THIS IS A VERY COMPLEX PROJECT IN TERMS OF SOME CHALLENGES. IN LOT OF STAKEHOLDERS ENDED UP BEING BROUGHT INTO THE PROJECT, IT'S TAKEN US

LONGER, AND THERE WERE ISSUES ABOUT SOURCING MATERIALS AND FIGURING OUT WHAT PLANTS WERE GOING TO LOOK LIKE AS THAT TIME OF THE YEAR.

It's a harsh environment to green, and to put a garden or a park in, but it's been great to see the water conservation and rain water project coming into fruition. Water was always going to be a limiting factor and the plant choices have been well-thought of. So many learnings can come from this to inform future landscaping. Creating rain garden planters, the shelter with the green roof, pipes and water butts.

PLANTERS HAVE RESERVOIRS BUILT INTO THEM SO THIS IS A RAIN WATER HARVESTING PROJECT. It'S A SMALL-SCALE PROJECT THAT IS SCALABLE. HAVING MULTIPLE PEOPLE INVOLVED WITH DIFFERENT SKILLS MEANS THIS COULD BE A GENUINELY SUSTAINABLE PROJECT; NO POCKET PARK HAS BEEN DESIGNED OR ENGINEERED IN THIS WAY. - ROSIE

THE ETHNOGRAPHER'S VISION

IN 2020, I INTERVIEWED MINDY FOR ANOTHER PROJECT AND SHE TOLD ME ABOUT THE POCKET PARK IDEA. I WAS IMMEDIATELY SMITTEN. I FELL IN LOVE WITH JARMAN'S WORK IN THE LATE BOS THROUGH MARIANNE FAITHFULL'S BROKEN ENGLISH VIDEO, AND LATER WITH CARAVAGGIO. AS I GOT INTO FILM AND VIDEO MAKING IN THE EARLY 90S, I FOUND SNIPPETS OF JUBILEE AND THE GARDEN HAUNTING EVEN IF I HAD TO CONSUME HIS WORK IN SMALL DOSES.

I DON'T KNOW ANY OTHER FILM MAKER THAT MATCHES HIM IN HIS SKILLS OF MAKING THE ONEIRIC SO PALPABLE. BUT, ALONG WITH HIS SET DESIGN, SUPER 8 FILMS, AND ACTIVISM, IT IS THE WHOLE OF JARMAN'S LIFE-AS-ART THAT TRULY INSPIRED ME, WITH THE GARDEN IN DUNGENESS AS THE MASTERPIECE ENCAPSULATING ALL THE CREATOR'S OPPOSING FACETS. THE EXPERIENCE OF BEING INVOLVED IN THE CO-CREATION OF A POCKET PARK TO CELEBRATE THIS MULTI-FACETED, KALEIDOSCOPIC GENIUS HAS BEEN THRILLING. FROM THE PERSPECTIVE OF AN ANTHROPOLOGIST OF GREEN SPACES, THE RESEARCH REVEALED JUST HOW SOCIAL HUMAN-NATURE INTERACTION CAN BE.

I KEPT A FIELD DIARY OF THE CO-CREATION PROCESS WITH OBSERVATIONS ABOUT HOW THE DIFFERENT PARTS ASSEMBLED TOGETHER. I PARTICIPATED IN MEETINGS AND GATHERED STORIES ABOUT THE PEOPLE IN THE COLLECTIVE. PEOPLE'S ENGAGEMENT WITH THE IDEAL AND ACTUAL GARDEN BROUGHT DIFFERENT ACTORS TOGETHER AND CONNECTIONS WERE MADE. THE ARCHITECTURE SUPERVISEE WHO HAD NEVER HEARD OF DEREK JARMAN USED THE POCKET PARK AS A CASE STUDY ELABORATING DESIGNS THAT WERE FREE FROM THE SPATIAL-TEMPORAL CONSTRAINTS OF REAL LIFE.

There were other research findings which will be explored elsewhere, but for now it suffice to say that this project is a valuable case study for co-production. Still ongoing, it keeps us walking, because it is about the process. - Luciana



GROWING CONNECTIONS

AND BUILDING BRIDGES

RFTER MONTHS OF CAREFUL PLANNING AND OVERCOMING MANY CHALLENGES, WE FINALLY MANAGED TO GET OUR HANDS INTO SOIL AND START PLANTING. TO REFLECT THE TIME OF YEAR, WE HAVE PLANTED A SELECTION OF BEAUTIFUL HELLEBORES, YELLOW STEMMED DOGWOOD AND PITTOSPORUM. BY WE MOVE INTO SPRING AND SUMMER, THE TULIPS AND DAFFODILS WILL COME INTO FLOWER AND PERENNIAL GRASSES SUCH AS MISCANTHUS WILL START TO SHOW THEIR NEW FOLIAGE.

WE STARTED TO BUILD IN SUSTAINABILITY TO OUR PLANS, HAVING CONVERSATIONS ABOUT PLANTERS WITH RESERVOIRS, RAIN CHAINS AND GREEN ROOFS.

HOME. MY CHOSEN FAMILY, LGBT
MANCHESTER, IS INCREDIBLY PRECIOUS TO
ME. WALKING IN TO MRG AND FEELING I
BELONG HERE' IS TREMENDOUS. (MINDY)

THE DEREK JARMAN POCKET PARK CAN BE SEEN AS A CONTACT ZONE FOR MANCHESTER BRT GALLERY WHERE PEOPLE OF DIFFERENT IDENTITIES, ETHNICITIES, AGES, AND TASTES ARE ENCOURAGED TO OVERCOME THRESHOLD FEARS AND ENGAGE WITH THE MUSEUM BUILDING AND COLLECTIONS AS A COMMONS, A SPACE THAT BELONGS TO THE PEOPLE. BY THE LAUNCH, WE DECIDED TO DO A VOXPOPULI TO GET A SENSE OF THE VISITOR'S EXPERIENCE:



"I'VE BEEN COMING TO THE ART GALLERY FOR A YEARS AND THIS (OUTSIDE SPACE) WAS ALWAYS A DEAD SPACE, AN INDETWEEN SPACE, AN UNCOMFORTABLE SPACE, A SPACE WITHOUT IDENTITY. THE SUSTAINABLE GARDEN

WHILE DEREK WRESTLED WITH A WILD SEA AND THE OCCASIONAL STORM, WE HAD THE CHALLENGES OF A CITY CENTRE LOCATION AND LISTED BUILDING STATUS TO CONTEND WITH. DURING OUR PLANTING SESSIONS AND AS THE GARDEN TOOK SHAPE, WE REFLECTED BACK TO OUR SUMMER VISITS TO OTHER GREEN SPACES IN AND AROUND MANCHESTER, PARTICULARLY THE IGNITION PROJECT AT SALFORD UNIVERSITY. AT THAT TIME, WE HAD NO IDEA HOW WE WOULD ACHIEVE THE LEVEL OF WATER CONSERVATION THAT WAS NEEDED TO MAKE THE GARDEN SUSTAINABLE. IT WAS ONLY THROUGH THE ADDITIONAL UNITED UTILITIES FUNDING AND THE INGENIOUS, BESPOKE DESIGN CREATED BY LEON DAVIS FOR THE GARDEN'S SHELTER THAT THIS VITAL ASPECT OF THE GARDEN HAS BEEN REALISED.

THE SHELTER NOT ONLY PROVIDES A FOCAL POINT AND A PLACE TO SIT BUT ALSO

INCLUDES A SEDUM ROOF, CAREFULLY HIDDEN WATER TANKS AND A RAINWATER CHAIN. FILL THESE FEATURES ALONG WITH THE CLEVERLY CONSTRUCTED PLANT CONTAINERS, MEAN THAT LIMITED ADDITIONAL WATER (ALONG WITH MANCHESTER'S GENEROUS RAINFALL!) WILL BE NEEDED FOR THE GARDEN THROUGHOUT THE YEAR.

DESIGNED BY AWARD WINNING LANDSCAPE ARTIST LEON DAVIS AND BASED ON HIS (GOLD WINNING!) RESILIENCE GARDEN FROM RHS FLOWER SHOW TATTON PARK IN 2021. THE DESIGN REFERENCES JARMAN'S PROSPECT COTTAGE MATERIALS AND COLOUR SCHEME. NOT ONLY DOES THE SHELTER PROVIDE AN ESCAPE FROM MANCHESTER'S INCLEMENT WEATHER AND VIEWPOINT TO THE GARDEN, IT ALSO INCLUDES A NUMBER OF INGENIOUS ENVIRONMENTAL FEATURES.

A JOURNEY TO DUNGENESS



WITH THE GARDEN BEGINNING TO ESTABLISH ITSELF THOUGHTS NATURALLY TURNED TO OUR LONG-AWAITED LONG AWAITED VISIT TO PROSPECT COTTAGE AND DUNGENESS. THE ORIGINAL VISIT WAS PLANNED OVER TWO YEARS AGO, AT THE VERY BEGINNING OF OUR GARDEN JOURNEY, BUT COVID HAS MEANT WE'VE HAD TO USE OUR IMAGINATION AND CREATIVITY TO DRIVE THE PROJECT FORWARD.

BUT NOW THE TIME HAD COME! WITH THE SUPPORT OF THE MANCHESTER WELLBEING FUND WE SET OFF FROM MANCHESTER PICCADILLY ON A BRIGHT AND SUNNY SEPTEMBER MORN FOR THE JOURNEY SOUTHWARDS.

THERE WAS A MIXTURE OF EXCITEMENT BUT ALSO APPREHENSION AS WE BOARDED THE TRAIN.

How would it feel to finally be standing in the place we'd all thought about, talked about, and imagined for so long? Would it be as we imagined?

THE MORNING OF OUR TRIP TO PROSPECT COTTAGE WAS BLESSED WITH GLORIOUS BLUE SKIES, SUNSHINE AND HARDLY A BREATH OF WIND AS WE ARRIVED AT DUNGENESS.

WE WERE REMINDED OF DEREK'S OWN THOUGHTS ON THE LANDSCAPE AS WE STEPPED FOOT ON THE SHINGLE FOR THE FIRST TIME: "Dungeness, Dungeness, your beauty is the best, forget the hills and valleys. This landscape is like the face you overlook, the face of an angel with a naughty smile."

PROSPECT COTTAGE STOOD OUT WITH ITS WELCOMING YELLOW AND BLACK COLOUR SCHEME, STILL LOOKING A VERY LIVED-IN COTTAGE AND A VERY LOVED HOME. HOWEVER, THE SURROUNDINGS BEYOND THE COTTAGE AND ITS GARDEN WERE STRANGE—THE VAST SHINGLE BEACH STRETCHING AWAY FROM THE COTTAGE BUT THE SEA NOT QUITE VISIBLE, THE NEIGHBOURING COTTAGES AND BUNGALOWS SPACED OUT ALONG THE ROAD, LOOKING A BIT LIFELESS IN COMPARISON TO PROSPECT COTTAGE AND CLOSER THAN I IMAGINED, THE DOMINATING PRESENCE OF SIZEWELL NUCLEAR POWER STATION.

WE WERE LUCKY TO HAVE SUCH A LOVELY MORNING TO SPEND TIME IN THE GARDEN AS IT'S THE SORT OF GARDEN THAT ENCOURAGES YOU TO WANDER, NOTICE SOMETHING, PONDER ON IT FOR A WHILE AND THEN MOVE ON. WHAT FEELS LIKE A NEVER-ENDING MAZE OF PATHWAYS TAKES YOU IN UNEXPECTED DIRECTIONS. THE CONSTANT SOUND OF CRUNCHING PEBBLES AS YOU WALK ADDING TO THE EXPERIENCE. CALMING AND MEDITATIVE. THE SCULPTURES WERE EVERYWHERE, SOMETIMES HIDDEN AMONG THE PLANTING AND AT OTHER TIMES STANDING OUT - I LOVED THE WAY HE HAD USED SO MUCH RUSTED METAL AS WELL AS THE DRIFTWOOD AND HAG STONES AND HOW EVERYTHING BLENDED TOGETHER TO CREATE SUCH AN INTRIGUING AND UNEXPECTED GARDEN. WE SPENT MOST OF THE DAY EXPLORING THE GARDEN; LOOKING AT THE PLANTS, THE AMAZING ARCHITECTURAL ELEMENTS AND TAKING IN THE SURROUNDING LANDSCAPE.

UNDERTAKING THIS VISIT TOGETHER AS A GROUP WAS VERY SPECIAL, SHARING IN EACH OTHER'S IMPRESSIONS, FEELINGS, AND THOUGHTS.

DEREK SETTLED HERE, IN DUNGENESS
READY TO FACE THE INEVITABLE END
BUT WHILE DOING SO HE MADE A
GARDEN FOR THE FUTURE, FACING
OUT TO SEA, TO THE FAR HORIZON.

FOLLOWING DEREK JARMAN'S DEATH IN 1994, HE BEQUEATHED PROSPECT COTTAGE TO HIS CLOSE COMPANION, KEITH COLLINS. KEITH LIVED AT THE COTTAGE UNTIL HIS DEATH IN 2018, MAINTAINING IT AS IT HAD BEEN WHEN DEREK WAS ALIVE. AFTER A PERIOD OF UNCERTAINTY ABOUT THE FUTURE OF PROSPECT COTTAGE, A SUCCESSFUL PRT FUND CAMPAIGN TOOK PLACE IN 2020 TO SAVE THE COTTAGE AND ITS CONTENTS FOR THE NATION. THIS MEANS THAT IT CAN CONTINUE TO BE A PLACE THAT ANYONE CAN VISIT TO LEARN AND BE INSPIRED BY JARMAN'S LEGACY. CREATIVE FOLKSTONE ARE THE CUSTODIANS, AND IT WAS THEIR STAFF, HAMISH AND RUEBEN WHO GREETED US AND SHOWED US ROUND THE COTTAGE DURING OUR VISIT.

THE TOURS OF THE COTTAGE ARE CARRIED OUT WITH GREAT SENSITIVITY AND RESPECT, ACKNOWLEDGING THAT THIS WAS DEREK'S FINAL HOME, CHERISHING HIS MEMORY AND ENSURING THAT IT DOESN'T BECOME TRIVIALISED OR TAKEN FOR GRANTED BY THOSE WHO ARE LUCKY ENOUGH TO VISIT. CREATIVE FOLKSTONE PURPOSEFULLY AVOID GIVING A SET GUIDED TOUR OF THE COTTAGE. INSTEAD, VISITORS ARE ENCOURAGED TO SPEND TIME QUIETLY IN THE COTTAGE, REFLECTING ON ITS CONTENTS AND ATMOSPHERE AS WELL AS BEING GIVEN THE OPPORTUNITY TO ASK QUESTIONS OR DISCUSS DEREK'S LIFE AND WORK.

I HAD BEEN LOOKING FORWARD
TO OUR TRIP TO DUNGENESS AND
PROSPECT COTTAGE WITH A MIXTURE OF
EXCITEMENT, ANTICIPATION BUT ALSO SOME
NERVOUSNESS, HOW WOULD I FEEL ABOUT
VISITING THE PLACE WE HAD TALKED ABOUT.

VISUALISED AND HAD BEEN OUR INSPIRATION FOR THE LAST TWO YEARS? I LOVED THE SENSATION OF CRUNCHING OVER THE STONES AS I WALKED AROUND THE GARDEN AND THE FEEL OF THE WOOD AND ARCHITECTURAL ELEMENTS. THE OPPORTUNITY TO VISIT PROSPECT COTTAGE WAS UNDOUBTEDLY THE HIGHLIGHT, I FELT HIS PRESENCE IN EVERY ROOM, IT WAS AN INCREDIBLY MOVING AND PERSONAL EXPERIENCE. (PAUL)

WE ALL FOUND IT A VERY THOUGHTPROVOKING AND MOVING EXPERIENCE. DEREK'S
SPIRIT TRULY LIVES ON AT PROSPECT COTTAGE
AND EACH ROOM FELT LIVED IN. IT WAS AS
THOUGH DEREK HAD JUST STEPPED OUT FOR
A SHORT TIME, LEAVING HIS WRITING AND
CREATIVE MATERIALS WHERE THEY WERE, HIS
PAINTING SHOES TUCKED UNDER HIS STUDIO
TABLE AND EVERYTHING READY TO MAKE HIS
NEXT MEAL IN THE TINY KITCHEN.

I WAS AMAZED BY THE ATMOSPHERIC VIBE OF THE GARDEN AT PROSPECT COTTAGE AND FELT THE NEED TO LIE DOWN ON THE SHINGLE AND BATH IN THE SUNSHINE. INSIDE LOOKING AT THE ART WORKS GAVE ME SUCH INSPIRATION OF HOW I COULD INCORPORATE SOME OF THE IDEAS INTO MY OWN GARDEN AT HOME. (DAVID)

I FOUND THE INTERIOR OF THE COTTAGE
TO BE EXCEPTIONALLY MOVING, THE
FURNISHINGS AS HE LEFT IT. TO SEE
AND FEEL HOW HE LIVED IN SUCH SERENE
TRANQUILLITY, SO ATMOSPHERIC. (PHILIP,
VOLUNTEER GARDENER)

THE FILM R JOURNEY TO DUNGENESS, MADE BY SCOUT STUART WITH ARTIST JULIET DAVIS-DUFAYARD, FOLLOWS THE GROUP'S JOURNEY TO JARMAN'S HOME AND GARDEN AND REFLECTS THE EXPERIENCE THROUGH THEIR OWN VOICES.

WE HAD PORED OVER PHOTOS
AND DESCRIPTIONS OF JARMAN'S
DUNGENESS HOME FOR THE PAST TWO
YEARS, BUT THIS DIDN'T DAMPEN
OUR EXCITEMENT AT SEEING THE REAL
THING, ALMOST TO THE POINT THAT WE
WOULDN'T HAVE BEEN SURPRISED TO
SEE DEREK HIMSELF, STANDING IN THE
YELLOW-FRAMED DOORWAY OR TENDING
THE GARDEN...THE GARDEN THAT WE
HAD READ AND HEARD AND THOUGHT
SO MUCH ABOUT.

HAVING NO PHYSICAL BOUNDARIES, THE GARDEN INVITES VISITORS TO WANDER, FOLLOWING THE PATHWAYS BETWEEN SHRUBS AND SCULPTURES, CIRCLING THE COTTAGE ITSELF. THE SOOTHING CRUNCH OF SHINGLE BENEATH OUR FEET WAS A CONSTANT CALMING SOUNDTRACK THROUGHOUT OUR VISIT.

THE COTTAGE EVOKED SMELLS FROM MY CHILDHOOD: POLISHED WOOD AND RAG RUGS. WE WERE IN THE INTIMATE INTERIOR OF AN ARTIST AS HE FACED HIS ENDING ON THIS EARTH. THE BOOKSHELVES TRACK HIS READING AND I WANTED TO FOLLOW, TO SEE HOW HE CONNECTED THE TEXTS AND IDEAS. THE GARDEN HAD ME DWELL ON THE ACTION OF TIME AND LIGHT ON MATERIAL OBJECTS.

LOOKING UP I SAW A LINE OF MIGRANTS'
SILHOUETTES TRUDGING UP THE SHINGLE
BEACH, DID THEY EXPERIENCE THIS PLACE AS
A HAVEN ON THE EDGE AS JARMAN DID?
DEREK SETTLED HERE, IN DUNGENESS READY
TO FACE THE INEVITABLE END BUT WHILE
DOING SO HE MADE A GARDEN FOR THE
FUTURE, FACING OUT TO SEA, TO THE FAR
HORIZON (MINDY).

I NOTICED PREOCCUPATIONS: CIRCLES
AND PATTERNS AND REPEATING THEMES.
THE GARDEN IS A WORLD OF FOUND
OBJECTS, WHERE THEIR PLACEMENT
EXALTS THEM ABOVE MERE EXISTENCE.
'Use what is there' is a start for all
ART ISN'T IT? I WAS MOVED TO SEE THE
GLASS FLOATS IN ONE CABINET. IN THE
1960'S THEY BEGAN TO BE REPLACED
BY MORE DURABLE PLASTIC ONES AND
THOSE THAT SURVIVED FOUND A NEW
LIFE AS BEAUTIFUL THINGS. I HAVE A
GREEN ONE, STILL IN ITS ROPE CASING,
THAT I FOUND, BOBBING IN A POOL ON
AN RINGLESEY BEACH IN 1963 (MINDY)

THE VISIT WAS AN AUDIO TRACK OF SHINGLES AS WE WALKED ON THEM, THEIR GRAINY SOUND BLURRED WITH PEOPLE'S VOICES AND MY OWN CORPOREAL UNSTEADINESS AS I STEPPED ON UNEVEN GROUND.

IT WAS ALSO AN EMBODIED EXPERIENCE OF SENSORIAL OVERLOAD UPON ENCOUNTERING JARMAN'S PERSONAL SPACES, TASTES, AND ALL THE IDIOSYNCRASIES THAT POPULATE THE WALLS OF PROSPECT COTTAGE. ONE OF US SUGGESTED WE SHOULD HAVE A LIST OF HIS BOOKS SO WE COULD CATCH A GLIMPSE OF HIS CREATIVE PROCESS.

REFLECTIONS ON CO-PRODUCTION

THE MOTIVATION FOR DOING CO-RESEARCH WAS ROOTED ON THE WORK CONDUCTED BY MURRG, THE MANCHESTER INSTITUTE OF COLLABORATIVE RESEARCH ON REGING, AND BY THE PARTNERSHIP DEVELOPED BETWEEN RMBITION FOR REGING EQUALITY PANEL AND THE LEBT FOUNDATION.

In our understanding, co-research includes encouraging community members to shape the research, and involves sharing stories and experiences to then reflect and learn through the research process.

PARTICIPATORY RESEARCH HAS THE POTENTIAL TO OFFER A WAY FORWARD IN ENGAGING OLDER PEOPLE IN A WAY THAT CAN BENEFIT THEM AS INDIVIDUALS, THEIR COMMUNITIES, AND THE PROCESS OF DEVELOPING AGE-FRIENDLY CITIES. (TIME BUFFEL, MURRG DIRECTOR)

DEVELOPING CO-PRODUCTION APPROACHES
TO INVOLVE OLDER PEOPLE IN THE
REGENERATION OF THEIR COMMUNITIES
HELPS MOVE BEYOND MAINSTREAM
METHODS OF CONSULTATION. (SOPHIE
YARKER, MURRG DEPUTY DIRECTOR)

BY SHIFTING THE POWER AND WORKING WITH OUR COMMUNITIES, A DIFFERENT PERSPECTIVE IS GAINED THAT WILL CHALLENGE AGEISM AND INCREASE OUR UNDERSTANDING OF THE EXPERIENCE OF URBAN AGEING. (PATTY DORAN, MURRG DEPUTY DIRECTOR)



INHERITED FROM THE POLITICAL PAMPHLETS OF THE ABOLITIONIST ERA, AND LATER ADOPTED BY FEMINIST AND QUEER MOVEMENTS, ZINES ARE SELF-PUBLISHED MATERIAL THAT DOCUMENT THE VOICES OF COMMUNITIES AT THE MARGINS. WHEN INSTITUTIONS ADOPT ZINE-MAKING, IT IS CRUCIAL TO ACKNOWLEDGE THIS TOOL'S POLITICAL ROOTS AND PURPOSES. OTHERWISE, IT RISKS BEING DEPOLITICISED, ABSTRACTED AS A SIMPLE CRAFT. ZINE-MAKING IS A FORM OF VISUAL CARETAKING, A WAY TO EXCHANGE RESOURCES AND EMPATHISE WITH ONE'S PEERS. (TAMARA HART, VISUAL ANTHROPOLOGIST)

Our vision was to connect communities and people through the creation of relationships, putting older people at the heart of designing the places where they live. Co-production has been a golden thread running throughout the programme as it helped to ampuify the voices of older people from marginalised communities and Pride in Reeing has been an exemplar of such an approach. 
CO-RESEARCH ALLOWS UNEXPECTED CONNECTIONS TO RISE TO THE SURFACE. THE LIFE STORIES OF THE GROUP REFLECT THOSE OF THE WIDER LGBTQ+ COMMUNITIES IN THAT MANY OF US MOVED TO LARGER CITIES LIKE MANCHESTER BECAUSE THEY ARE WONDERFUL, ACCEPTING PLACES TO BE - BUT THEN WE BEAR THE BRUNT OF THE EFFECTS OF CUMATE CHANGE ON URBAN SPACES, SUCH AS EXTREME HEAT, POLLUTION AND LACK OF GREEN SPACE. I THINK THIS IS ONE OF THE REASONS WHY WE'VE FELT A STRONG EMOTIONAL DRIVE TO CREATING THIS SPACE, GIVING SOMETHING GREEN AND SUSTAINABLE BACK TO A CITY THAT HAS CELEBRATED AND WELCOMED US AS A COMMUNITY. SEEING THE DEVELOPMENT OVER TIME IS REALLY IMPORTANT. FOR EXAMPLE, THERE ARE MEMBERS OF THE GROUP THAT HAVE HEALTH CHALLENGES. SO, THE LONGEVITY OF THE INTERVENTION REALLY MATTERS AND THERE ARE THINGS THAT WE MAY NOT TELL YOU IN YEAR ONE THAT WE CAN TELL YOU IN YEAR THREE BECAUSE OUR LIVES WILL HAVE CHANGED. (MINDY, PRIDE IN FIGEING)

CO-PRODUCTION TRANSLATES INTO CONSTANT HORIZONTAL LEARNING AS WE BOUNCE IDEAS AND INSIGHTS OFF EACH OTHER. IT INVITES US TO STEP INTO OTHER PEOPLE'S SHOES TO SEE THINGS FROM THEIR POINT OF VIEW.
CO-PRODUCING ALSO MEANS HAVING TO WORK WITH OUR COMPANION SPECIES THAT ARE AN ESSENTIAL PART OF OUR COMMONS, SUCH AS PLANTS, INSECTS AND WATER IN A MORE SYMBIOTIC WAY.

MINDY AT THE INTERNATIONAL DAY OF OLDER PEOPLE, THIS YEAR DEDICATED TO THE FIGHT AGAINST CLIMATE CHANGE.

THE 16 PANELS GENERATE ELECTRICITY
FOR THE NATIONAL GRID AND AN
INCOME. THE TOP 2 ARE HOT WATER

As to the group's suggestions to make Manchester a more age friendly place:

- I. More public seating as walking for sustained periods can be too much of a challenge.
- 2. BETTER PUBLIC TRANSPORT INCLUDING STAFFING ON SAID TRANSPORT TO ENSURE SAFETY FROM HARASSMENT.
- 3. More publicly resourced health and wellbeing activities such as singing groups, walking groups and community gardens

AND HERE ARE SOME SUGGESTIONS BY VISITORS TO THE DEREK JARMAN POCKET PARK:

"There's a definite need for space where you can sit down and breathe. I'm also interested in the informal connections that can occur in a welcoming place like this, rather than a formal events space this part of the art gallery grounds hasn't been used that much, there's never been much happening in this space. It's quite corporate around here but now you have plants, splashes of colour.

I'D LIKE TO SEE MORE GREEN SPACES OPEN TO THE PUBLIC, PLACES TO COME AND SIT DOWN AND WATCH THE WORLD GO BY. IT MEETING PLACE FOR PEOPLE IN QUITE A BUILT-UP AREA, IT'S A NICE TO HAVE THIS POCKET OF RELIEF FOR PEOPLE TO COME SIT, AND RELAX.

THE GARDEN IS A WAY TO BRING PRIDE IN REGING INTO PEOPLE'S MINDS. PEOPLE CAN COME AND SIT BUT AT THE SAME TIME LEARN ABOUT THE OLDER LGBT COMMUNITY. IT REALLY DOES BROADEN PEOPLE'S MINDS.

IT WAS ALWAYS ONE OF THOSE SPACES THAT PEOPLE TRAVEL THROUGH ON THEIR WAY TO OTHER SPACES. BUT NOW I THINK YOU'D STOP RATHER THAN WALK THOUGH. IT DRAWS YOU IN MUCH MORE THAN BEFORE."

Grew up in Manchester and Piccadilly

THE POCKET PARK INTO THE FUTURE

WE ARE LOOKING TO EXPAND THE VOLUNTEER GROUP TO INCLUDE MORE PEOPLE. THE GROUP WILL CONTINUE TO MAINTAIN THE GARDEN AND ARE NOW LOOKING AT HOW WE CAN HELP ENCOURAGE MORE ORGANIC PEST CONTROL AND BIODIVERSITY THROUGH PLANTING, TRIALLING ORGANIC PEST SOLUTIONS AND BIRD FEEDERS. THE GROUP ARE GROWING PLANTS AT HOME FROM SEED TO PLANT INTO THE GARDEN TO ENCOURAGE SEASONAL COLOUR (RATHER THAN BUY BEDDING PLANTS AND LESS SUSTAINABLE PLANTING OPTIONS).

WE ARE LOOKING FOR FUNDING TO CREATE PROGRAMMING, SUCH AS SKETCHING, CLIMATE JUSTICE KNOWLEDGE SHARING SESSIONS ETC., AND WOULD LIKE TO EMPLOY A GARDENER TO WORK WITH THE GROUP. HOWEVER, THIS ALL DEPENDS ON SECURING NEW FUNDING AS THE POCKET PARKS GRANT HAS NOW BEEN SPENT.
